Per our conversations today, here is the spec for milling the stringers, treads and risers for the Green Woodlands stair. All pieces to be jointed on an adjacent face and edge and thickened as described here and shown in the appended drawing.

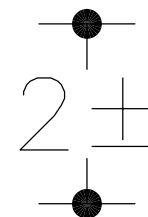
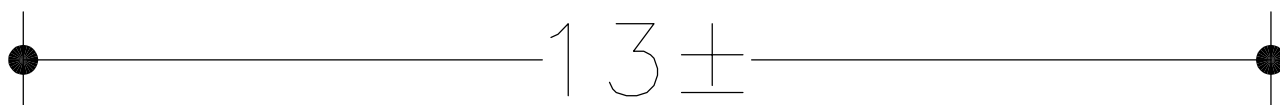
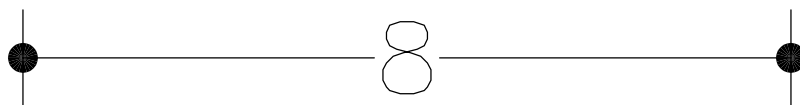
Stringers should finish at 4" x 12" (or as close to 12" as we can get), risers at 1x8, treads at 2x13. I understand that we may not be able to hold full 2" or even 1 7/8" on the treads, but, given that we have almost twice the material we need, perhaps the selection process can cull for size as well as quality.

In order to complete shop drawings, I need to know the actual size of the parts, so please get back to me with these dimensions when you can.

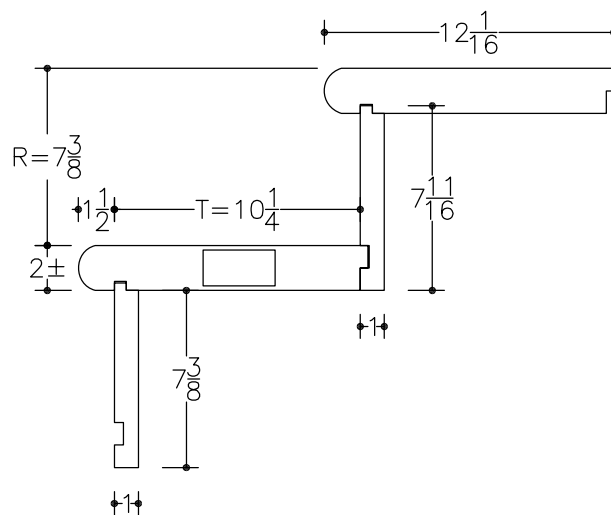
GREEN WOODLANDS BARN
